Hospice of NJ

Aging in place (home, assisted living, nursing home) is happening within every community across the United States. Families struggle everyday with the day-to-day caregiving responsibilities and many do not know one of the most robust benefits provided by Medicare/Medicaid.

The service is called Hospice. To many this word has a negative connotation because someone they love is at their end of life. Don't struggle alone when there is a benefit available 24/7 for you and your family.

Hospice's mission is to walk alongside those we serve to provide end-of-life care with respect and dignity. A hospice team takes pride in helping patients, families, and all their loved ones by providing excellent care and support. The support begins with a personalized plan of care, specifically by the patient's physician and the hospice's medical director and interdisciplinary team.

Hospice benefits covered under Medicare:

- Medical equipment: hospital bed, mattress, wheelchair, walker, oxygen, commode etc.
- Medical supplies: incontinent supplies, personal care, gloves etc.
- On-call nurse and staff available 24 hours a day, 7 days per week.
- Nurse visits, aide visits, social worker, spiritual care, volunteers, bereavement/grief counseling.
- ♦ Medications for symptom and pain management.

4 levels of care provided:

- Routine care provided wherever someone lives. (home, assisted living, nursing home)
- 2. Respite care provided to give temporary relief to a patient's caregiver.
- 3. Continuous care requires direct care/symptom management between 8-24 hours a day.
- 4. Inpatient care provided in a facility with 24 hour staffing when patient's symptoms are not controlled, such as pain.

Help prevent the back and forth to the emergency room and let <u>Hospice of New Jersey</u> walk by your side and help through the last steps of life's journey.


