National Highway Transportation Safety Administration (NHTSA) has declared December as Impaired Drivers' Month as the time between Nov. 29 and Jan. 1 is particularly deadly. Impaired driving includes drunk driving and buzzed driving—being under the influence of other substances or drugs—legally prescribed, over-the-counter drugs or illicit drugs. If you "feel different" you drive different. And that doesn't mean you drive better!!

#### A few facts to keep in mind this holiday season:

- Alcohol, marijuana, and other drugs impair the ability to drive because they slow coordination, judgment, and reaction times.
- ♦ Cocaine and methamphetamine can make drivers more aggressive and reckless.
- Using two or more drugs at the same time, including alcohol, can amplify the impairing effects of each drug a person has consumed.
- Some prescription and over-the-counter medicines can cause extreme drowsiness, dizziness, and other side effects. Read and follow all warning labels before driving, and note that warnings against "operating heavy machinery" include driving a vehicle.

#### Responsible behavior:

- ◊ If you are drinking or impaired by drugs, do not drive!
- Plan a safe ride home *before* you start the party.
- Use a designated driver, Uber, LYFT or local taxi service.
- If someone you know has been drinking, or taken medications that impair judgment, do not let that person get behind the wheel. Take the keys and arrange an alternate sober way for them to get home.
- If you are hosting a party where alcohol or other substances are served, make sure all guests leave with a sober driver.
- Always wear your seatbelt, it's the best defense against impaired drivers.
- If you see an impaired driver on the road, notify police.
  Your actions could save someone's life.

This is time to be joyful, celebrate with family and friends, and be a part of this festive season. Please do it safely for all concerned. Happy Holiday Season to all; celebrate and drive safely.


